Ab dem 01. Juli 2010 ist kein „Permit“ mehr vorzulegen für die Novice Youth und Novice Amateur Reiter. Diese können eingetragene Quarter Horses (keine Hengste) auf AQHA Shows vorstellen und zeigen. Alle anderen Regeln der AQHA bleiben wie bisher. Nachfolgend der Original Text der AQHA:

### **New Rules for Novice Competitors**

“A recommendation was made by the Show Council and then approved by the Executive Committee to allow novice competitors to participate without permits in the novice division at AQHA approved shows. The reasoning behind the decision is to bring more exhibitors to the AQHA show ring.

Beginning July 1, 2010, an exhibitor may show any mare or gelding in a novice youth or novice amateur class, with the owner and their immediate family still retaining the ability to show the horse in any class other than the same class as the novice exhibitor. Exhibitors will be required to have a novice amateur or novice youth membership to participate. Memberships can be purchased at the show or prior to the show through AQHA.

All novice eligibility rules still apply.“
